Require 'snapshot' of student work

Easy access to old learning material

Reduce backup requirement on live systems

Using permissions transforms how Moodle looks




Create course backups (mbz file)

Freezing introduced with Moodle 3.6


#### **Using Moodle permissions**

Significantly changes appearance/access





An "experimental" feature

Significantly changes appearance

• Only available in 3.6 Si




## The read\_only solution



Replace mysqli with mysqliro


All database updates silently thrown away

- No change to appearance
  - (apart from warning on login)



#### Freezing is experimental







You need Moodle 3.6

It changes the appearance of things

Some things cannot be frozen

moodle/lib/dml







Same principle for update and delete


