

Put activities into "stealth mode" to achieve particular designs for your courses

- Earlier versions of Moodle had a "quirk" that allowed activities to be hidden inside "extra" weeks or topics, but still be accessible to students. These were known as "orphaned" activities and allowed Moodle users to achieve particular designs for their courses.
- Now in Moodle 3.3 you can put any activity into "stealth mode" to achieve this same effect in a more officially-supported way.
- Teachers can now put activities into stealth mode so that they are not shown on the course page, but remain usable by students.
